Rick Littleton and the City of Franklin will be hosting our February meeting. This meeting will be a day meeting with our regular monthly meeting and lunch from 12 P.M. to 2 P.M. and plant tours of the Franklin Wastewater Treatment Plant being held from 2 P.M. to 4 P.M.

Plant Description: The Franklin plant has an average flow of 4.0 MGD and utilizes screening and grit removal, oxidation ditches, final clarification and sludge return, UV disinfection, ATAD digestion and land application of dry sludge. The newest addition to this process is the sludge drying facility. The Class A sludge is caked and mixed with fly ash for land application. This new system also has the ability to mix yard waste with the caked sludge for land application. The Franklin plant has 8 employees, running and maintaining the collection system, plant, lab and land application.

Directions to the Plant: From U.S. 31 going south, go one block south of U.S. 44. Turn East at the Cemetery on South Street. Go 4 stop signs and turn left on State Street. Go about a mile south to WWTP. Phone # 317-736-3640

Directions to Meeting The meeting will be held at the Parks recreation center. To get there it is the same as plant, but when you get to the last stop sign, which is a T, turn left. The Parks and Recreation is the building on that corner.
