Jeff Smith and the Town of Greensburg will be hosting our January meeting. Plant tours of the Greensburg Wastewater Treatment Plant will be held from 2 P.M. to 4 P.M. prior to our regular meeting. Dinner and our monthly meeting will be held Greensburg Town Hall.

**Plant Description:** The Greensburg WWTP is designed to treat an average daily flow of 8.9 MGD and a peak flow of 15.0 MGD. The treatment process consist of a finebar screen, aerated grit removal, primary clarification, two vertical loop reactors, final clarification tertiary filter and UV disinfection with effluent re-aeration. Waste activated sludge is thickened using a rotary drum thickener. Solids are treated in primary and secondary anaerobic digesters and a belt filter press is used for dewatering. Biosolids are land applied.

**Directions to the Plant:** Turn right onto Monfort Street at its intersection with Main Street. At 2<sup>nd</sup> stop sign, angle right on Broadway Street for about 100-150 feet. Turn left into plant drive. There will be a Greensburg WWTP sign and a Bowen Construction sign at the plant entrance. Please note, the plant is still under construction and very muddy at this time. **BOOTS AND HARD HATS ARE REQUIRED!**

**Directions to Meeting:** From the plant, go back North on Monfort Street to the traffic light. Turn left onto Main Street, go one block west to Ireland Street and turn right. Drive one block to Washington Street and turn right. Greensburg City Hall is on the left (former school building). Enter on the north side of the

building.

**Plant Tours:** 2 to 4 P.M. (Plant tours submitted for 1 contact hour).

**Dinner:** 4:30 P.M. **\$10.00** The menu will be Fried Chicken, Slaw, Baked Beans, Potato Salad, Cookies and Drinks. Joe Taylor assures me it will be yummy! ☺
