Jason Reister and the City of Seymour will be hosting our May meeting. Plant tours of the Seymour Wastewater Treatment Plant will be held from 2 P.M. to 4 P.M. prior to our regular meeting.

Plant Description: The Wastewater Treatment Plant is owned and managed by the City of Seymour. The Waste Water Treatment department is charged with the responsibility of the daily operation and maintenance of the City of Seymour's 8.7 million gallons/ day plant, the 125 miles of sanitary sewer, 25 miles of storm sewer collection systems, and 36 sanitary lift stations. The WWTP must meet or exceed all Federal, State and Local specifications for effluent quality control, and provide all required reports and obtain all permits for operation of the facilities. The WWTP also monitors 11 Industrial Users in the city to ensure compliance with city regulations.

Directions to the Plant: From I-65, take exit 50B for US-50 toward Seymour/Brownstown, turn right at E. Tipton St./US 50, turn right at Community Dr. turn left at W. 2nd St., make a slight right at Westgate Rd., turn right at Vehslage rd. and turn left at E. County Rd 525 N/New Ford Rd. A map is included at the end of the newsletter for your use.
